

**PADP 8640: Program Evaluation**  
**Assignment notes for Presentations**  
**(5-10 minutes)**  
**Presented in class, Tuesday April 26th**

For this assignment, you and your team are asked to prepare a brief presentation of your evaluation design. Pretend as if you are asked to come present to the BTC board and pitch your evaluation design--and your team--as the team that should receive the evaluation contract. You do not have very long so you'll have to focus on key points and be sure to tell a coherent story without going into a ton of detail. A few guidelines:

1. For the sake of this presentation, you can assume that the audience ("the board") has a good working knowledge of the program to be evaluated. Thus, focus on explaining your evaluation (research questions, research design, data collection, value provided by your evaluation) and not the program itself
2. Your team can handle presenting however you would like. You can provide handouts, use a visual aid such as a Powerpoint or Google Slides presentation, or use another method. Your team can use one or multiple presenters. If you use a computer slideshow, remember that you only have 5-10 minutes to present; you should plan on no more than 10 slides and likely aim for 5-7 main slides.
