



For the past twenty years, Republican control of Georgia's legislature has left too many communities behind. - Engage directly with voters through calls, texts, and in-person outreach

**A core expectation of this role is a willingness to canvass.** Door-to-door outreach remains the most effective method of voter mobilization, so it is essential that any intern be open to having conversations with voters about the candidate and campaign.

We strongly encourage women and students who have not traditionally seen themselves in political spaces to apply. We are building a team that reflects the community we serve.

This internship is, unfortunately, unpaid. Successful grassroots campaigns often have to rely on enthusiastic volunteers and community members. With this in mind, the campaign will work closely with students on their school/work/life balance, their expectations for their experience, and how we can respect their boundaries while holding them accountable to their commitments. Students will leave this experience with practical skills, professional connections, and a real understanding of how modern campaigns operate.
